

Appendix No. 2 to Resolution No. 305/2020 Senate of the Maria Grzegorzewska University of 31 March 2020

- 1. Individual Research Plan (IRP) guidelines:
- 1) It is developed by the doctoral student in consultation with the supervisor(s) and opinion of the assistant supervisor(s).
- 2) It includes:
 - a. a schedule of research activities (months), specifying the deadline for submitting the doctoral dissertation;
 - b. research project;
 - c. information on whether and where the doctoral student is applying for funding for a research project;
 - d. plans for active participation in academic conferences;
 - e. information about texts in preparation or submitted to publishers or scientific journals;
 - f. other planned activities (e.g., research internships, training) that are relevant to the preparation of the doctoral dissertation;
- 3) The IRP is prepared according to the specified form.
- 4) It is presented to the Head of the Doctoral School within 6 months of starting the program.
- 5) The Head of the Doctoral School and a representative of the discipline in which the doctoral student is conducting research (invited at the head's request) approve the proposal and/or provide feedback. After addressing the feedback, the doctoral student submits the final version of the IRP.
- 6) The IRP is subject to evaluation by the committee conducting the mid-term assessment regarding the extent of its implementation.
