Opis: The purpose of the conversion course is to prepare for conflict prevention and resolution in multicultural groups. It can also be helpful in conducting classes/training oriented to conflict resolution in general, which is important in a world marked by tensions and conflicts. During the course, the specifics of intercultural conflicts, their causes and consequences will be presented. Ways of resolving conflicts in culturally diverse groups taking into account cultural differences and intercultural communication will be discussed. Possibilities of counteracting intercultural conflicts in educational and non-educational settings using various tools will be also presented.
